


# Google Meet



Google Meet

In the coming weeks, we will be using Google Meet alongside our other platforms to help with home learning. Google Meet is a simple video conferencing tool, so we will be able to speak live.

Whilst on Meet, you will be able to ask questions and see your teacher and friends.

When using Google Meet to interact with your class and teachers, please ensure that you follow the rules.

- There will be two members of staff in a meeting, make sure to say hello.
- Children should turn off their camera if there is not a suitable, plain background. Your background should be a plain wall if possible.
- Children should put their hand up to answer a question and only un-mute themselves when answering.
- The way children talk to each other should reflect their behaviour in a real classroom.
- Any breaches of the rules will result in the child being blocked from that meeting.
